

Greetings from Union Baptist Church,

We are looking for a full time pastor to serve our congregation in compliance with 1 Peter 5:1-4, 1 Timothy 3:1-7, and Titus 1:5-9. Just as Christ came to serve, we need a man of God who is willing to serve the body of UBC, as unto the Lord. Our pastor of 16 years just resigned and we are eager to begin a new chapter with an individual called of God and a yearning to preach the inerrant word of God without apology (1 Timothy 4:12-16, Hebrews 4:12-3). We do not belong to the Southern Baptist Convention, nor do we adhere to their doctrine. We understand that although we are saved by the grace of God, our free will has never been negated and we are to live worthy of the Salvation which we have received (Luke 9:23, Philippians 1:27, Hebrews 12:14, 1 Peter 1:13-16) Apostasy, such as that described in Timothy 4:1-3, Hebrews 6:1-8, Hebrews 10:26-31, 2 Peter 2:20-22, and Jude 3-6, is unto the second death as God does not receive that which is out of his will 2 Corinthians 6:14-18. Just as Paul wrote to the Romans in Chapter 11 verses 13 through 24, if God spared not the natural branches due to disobedience, why would he not follow through with Jesus' words in John 15:1-6, as God is the husbandman that purgeth that which is unfruitful. As you can see, we are not Baptist and have plans to remove the Baptist from our name in God's timing.

Our Sanctuary will seat 250 plus congregants with a dry preacher baptistry, a pastors office fully furnished, newly remodeled Children's/Youth Department, Gymnasium/Kitchen, Library, a church van, and a 3 bedroom, two bath parsonage. We own all property and buildings and owe no notes. The Church operates with a church board and is governed by Church Bylaws and the guidance of our pastor as the Spirit leads. Our song service is a mix of traditional and contemporary with a choir, drums, guitars, piano, sax player, and ProPresenter 6 for all visual needs. Our nursery has a live feed of the service so the staff can participate in the service and Children's Church for those of the appropriate age. Our Sunday morning attendance varies between 50 and 80 congregants, but our core is roughly 30 dedicated members who function as the body described by Paul in 1 Corinthians Chapter 12. We have time for prayer at the altars after each service with anointing and special prayer for those in need (Luke 6:12, James 5:14-16). Our Services and Practices are as follows: Sunday Morning Praise Practice @ 9:00 a.m., Van leaves between 9:15 and 9:30 to start route, Sunday School starts @ 10:00 a.m., Worship begins @ 11:00 a.m. followed by the Message and Prayer, Sunday evening Discipleship Training starts @ 5:00 p.m. followed by Worship Service and Message @ 6:00 p.m., and Wednesday Night Word/Prayer Meeting at 7 pm.

We pray that God has called you, you who has answered the same call as Isaiah, "Here am I, send me", to come lead our congregation with the vision God has given you for his people and your ministry! We are established in the word, eagerly seeking to reach our community, and ready to submit to the authority of a Holy Ghost filled man of God. Please pray with us as we seek God's will and await the appointment of a new Shepard. We know by faith that all things are possible with God and pray for his perfect will and timing. Amen
