PURPOSE To build youth disciples for Christ by developing and implementing a comprehensive approach to youth ministry in the areas of group building, worship, discipleship, mission and outreach while serving as a spiritual leader and role model.

MINISTRY FOCUS To be committed to a relational style of ministry that promotes the love of Christ through dynamic relationships between youth, parents and volunteers which strengthens the positive teamwork attitude and the vision and philosophy of the church and youth ministry.

PRIMARY DUTIES (include but not limited to)

Administrative

- Adhere to the Alexander City Methodist Church Constitution.
- Oversee all youth programs, trips, ministries, internal communications and volunteers.
- Maintain the annual youth ministry budget and keep a constant grasp on the financial situation of budget line items.
- Attend monthly board meetings.

Youth Relation

- Monitor each youth member's attendance or lack of and spiritual growth or lack of.
- Maintain the youth communication database to include address, phone number and email.
- Set long term spiritual goals and objectives for the youth ministry program.
- Maintain a balance of programs to reach the core of students, congregation and the community.

- Integrate the youth into church ministry, service and functions.
- Spend time on student campuses and attend school functions/programs, sporting events, concerts, FCA, etc.
- Develop relationships with youth parents and work hand-in-hand to meet the student's spiritual needs.
- Counsel with youth and parents, if necessary.

Other

- Develop volunteers and maintain an open-door policy for parents and youth.
- Teach various Bible studies.
- Speak at functions other than those sponsored by ACMC which have been approved by the Senior Pastor or Church Board.
- Continue to learn about youth ministry through various continued educational opportunities.
- Assist Senior Pastor with various duties upon request. Visitations, filling the pulpit, etc.
- Attend all church functions.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Give evidence of personal faith in Jesus Christ and a call to youth ministry.
- Possess administrative and leadership abilities.
- Be energetic, a self-motivated leader and have the ability to work well with others.
- Be able to give and receive directions and instructions.
