

Indian Springs Holiness Campmeeting is a gathering in Flovilla, Georgia for Christians who desire to grow in depth in their relationship with Jesus, based on the teachings of John Wesley.

The Glenn Tabernacle, one of the camp ministries, is sacred ground for fun, fellowship and spiritual growth among the elementary age children. We have found that these children have eager hearts and can learn deep spiritual truths and apply them to their lives, despite their young age. Historically, these children are accustomed to coming to camp. It is a highlight of their summer, so much that they want to bring friends along. In the Glenn, music, puppets, crafts, games and storytelling are used to solidify spiritual learning. Indian Springs camp goers have a heart for missions! The children are always eager (and quite competitive) to earn money for missions. They will sell anything you can imagine (including frogs) and do chores to earn money. Missions is also a central focus of the Glenn.

The Glenn Ministry is from 9- 12:30 (children from 9:30-12) every morning and recreation is 2:30-4 every afternoon, from Friday July 14 to Sunday July 23 (no Glenn meeting on the 23rd).

We are looking for an enthusiastic, spirit filled, passionate individual to lead our 10-day in depth children's program at the Glenn Tabernacle. This individual would order supplies in advance of camp, implement the given curriculum (in keeping with the Wesleyan doctrine expounded in all the tabernacles), organize the various domains of the program, and lead the volunteers. Generally, we work with one director in charge of the Glenn, several leaders underneath to head up various activities and then additional workers. The director will be the spiritual and practical leader of the other workers, and must be able to set an atmosphere of enthusiasm, patience, and engagement with the children. This person needs a heart for children and a strong desire to guide their steps toward developing and/or strengthening their relationship with Jesus.

This is a great opportunity to develop leadership and implementation skills in a short term setting. Using your creativity to make the curriculum come alive is also encouraged! You will build relationships with children and be able to disciple them in their walk with Jesus. It is not unusual for children to make a profession of faith during their time at the Glenn. In addition, you will find a great support behind you in terms of the parents, workers, and board members who will assist you and pray for the ministry.
