LOCATION

Forest, Virginia is located in west central Virginia, within sight of the Blue Ridge Mountains. Mountain View Church is situated on approximately twelve acres, with a main sanctuary that seats about 300, a Fellowship Hall, and a "Youth Cave" for its youth programs.

Four public schools are located within a three mile radius of the church, serving approximately 3,300 students.

Primarily an English speaking community.



THE OPPORTUNITY

SENIOR PASTOR

The Senior Pastor, as both the spiritual leader and chief administrative officer of the church, is charged with guiding the spiritual journey and growth of the church and its members, administering all ministries and programs of the church, and supervising all church staff.

Having recently disaffiliated from the United Methodist Church, Mountain View Church is positioned to minister to the growing Forest, VA community with Spirit-led, Biblically-based ministries, worship, programs, and activities. Mountain View Church is seeking a dynamic and enthusiastic Senior Pastor to lead us in this journey.

KEY ATTRIBUTES DESIRED in the SENIOR PASTOR

Personal Traits

- Has a passion for being a pastor and for sharing Christ with all persons
- Is energetic and shows drive and initiative.
- Strong interpersonal skills, is approachable, is outgoing in nature, and demonstrates the ability to relate to all age groups
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively, leading and working with teams and volunteer groups

Theology and Cultural Issues

- Has a strong faith in God and Jesus Christ as God's Son and Savior and a passion for spreading the Gospel and furthering God's Kingdom
- Believes that the Bible is the inspired Word of God to mankind
- Holds to a conservative/traditional Biblical understanding of Scripture and the Christian faith, including on issues such as sexual immorality and gay marriage
- Affirms the view of marriage, gender, and identity consistently presented in the Bible

KEY ATTRIBUTES DESIRED (continued)

Preaching and Teaching

- Preaches from a Biblical foundation with Scriptural cross-references, applies sermons to modern day life, and speaks on a personal level
- Messages and sermons are rooted in the Scriptural teachings, using modern and creative approaches to delivering messages
- Demonstrates ability to speak extemporaneously
- Demonstrates an appreciation of the importance of all aspects of worship (e.g., preaching, teaching, music, prayer, etc.)

Administrative and Work-Related Skills

- Strong administrative and organizational skills, including planning, organizing, and directing the work
 of others (both paid staff and volunteers)
- Shows skill in pastoral care, including to those in need such as hospital visits, and a willingness to make pastoral care and visits a priority
- Demonstrates a willingness to get to know the congregation, including home visits

OUR CHURCH (continued)

Our History

In 1990 Forest United Methodist Church (UMC) and the Lynchburg UMC District began to explore expansion and relocation to meet the growing needs of the Forest, VA community. The Lynchburg District purchased an eight-acre tract of land in Forest and in January 1993 the New Church in Mission was established. After outgrowing meeting facilities in a local dance studio ballroom and rented community office space, ground breaking of the church facility that stands today on that eight-acre tract of land took place on June 2, 1996. Mountain View United Methodist Church was chartered as a local church by the Virginia Annual Conference in January 1997. Resulting from successful growth, a facility expansion was made in June 2003 for the existing sanctuary and additional classrooms. In April 2012, the construction of the Youth Cave was completed. The church purchased an additional four acres of contiguous property for future expansion in 2019.

In March 2022, Mountain View began activities to disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church. By August 2022, Mountain View Church was incorporated as a Virginian Nonprofit Religious Corporation. In December 2022, disaffiliation from the UMC was completed.

OUR MINISTRIES

- Jesus And Me (JAM) providing children's (preschool 5th grade) Biblical teaching during the Sunday worship hour
- ♦ Youth fellowship, Bible study, and missions activities for middle and high school students
- Adult Bible Studies and Small Groups Several women's, men's, and couples midweek Bible studies
- Music adult chancel choir and worship Praise Team and Band
- Various Small Group Ministries Blessing Blankets, Yarn Ministry, "From These Hands"
- ♦ An Active Missions Team! providing hands-on missions outreach to local organizations and nonprofits such as World Help, Bedford Christmas Station, and Lynchburg Daily Bread.
- Knight's Club a Christian-focused after school program and summer camp.

THE SELECTION PROCESS

- ♦ Identifying, screening, and interviewing qualified candidates is the task of a Pastor Search Committee made up of five Mountain View Church members.
- Final candidates may be invited to preach as a guest preacher.
- ♦ The final selection of our Senior Pastor is the responsibility of the Mountain View Church Board, with input from the congregation. The hiring and onboarding process will be administered by the Board's Staff Parish Relations Committee.
