- Planning worship in collaboration with the pastor
- Raising up volunteers and musicians

Beyond worship leadership, we are intentionally flexible.

Depending on the candidate's strengths, calling, and experience, the remaining hours could focus on areas such as:

- Discipleship & spiritual formation
- Youth or young adult ministry
- Administration or executive leadership
- Pastoral care
- Outreach & mission
- Or another ministry area aligned with the candidate's gifts

Our desire is not to fill a narrow job description — but to find the right ministry partner whom God is calling to serve among us.

- Has strong musical leadership skills in both traditional and contemporary contexts
